



Consignment Guidelines

We accept consignments for 2 types of auctions. Our Premier auctions consist of quality items that have a certain level of value, and are held in our gallery, all items are photographed, described, listed in a catalog and entered on the Internet. Bidding is done in our gallery by our in-house bidders plus live via the Internet. Our warehouse auctions are held in our warehouse, there is no catalog or photographs taken of each item. Items are auctioned off at random. When we inspect your consignments we will decide which auction they best fit.

We offer different options for consignment fees which will be discussed at the time of consignment. Reserve prices are strongly discouraged and not allowed for items under a \$300 value. To cover the cost of our services, including advertising, there will be a “no sale” fee for items that do not meet the reserve. Reserves are only accepted IF the reserve is at a reasonable level, agreed upon by the seller and Cady Auction.

Please call ahead to arrange for drop offs.

Items will be sold in the condition in which you drop them off. We do not clean or repair items. All items must be in good workable condition, the only exception would be antiques. Antiques in need of repair will be inspected and accepted on an individual basis. We reserve the right to refuse any items.

General list of items we will not accept (this is a general list & not to construed as complete)

- Broken items
- Books: except Antique, First edition, Autographed
- Electronics: Computers more than 2 yrs old, printers, copiers, scanners, radios, stereos, TVs. Any of these is less than 2 yrs old might be accepted.
- House hold: coffee cups, plastic containers, microwaves, small appliances, etc
- Glassware: FTD type vases, figurines that were purchased at a discount store,
- Lamps & light fixtures: (exceptions: antique, stained glass, unusual in some manner)
- Clothing unless vintage
- Bedding & Curtains of any kind (this includes blankets)
- Mattresses
- Upholstered furniture is only taken on a limited basis.
- Extremely soiled items.
- Plastic stuff
- Fake flowers
- Home decorative items, including pictures, unless they have antique or collectible value.
- Holiday items are only taken 60 days prior to the holiday they are for.
- Tires or garage items that are not usable or clean.

If these items are part of an estate, they will be discussed at the time of consignment.
